HANDICAP: 90% of 450

- 1) Tournament shall be governed by USBC Rules
 - 2) Entrants must be a USBC certified bowler and one of the following:
 - a. A current member of the Morris County Women's 600 Club
 - b. A qualified Guest member who is a member in good standing of any NJ Women's 600 Club
 - c. A qualified Guest member bowling with a current 600 Club Member
 - d. There is a fee of **\$5.00 for non-Morris County Women's 600 Club members**
 - 3) Three (3) games in each event will be bowled on the same pair of lanes.
 - 4) Entering averages will be determined in the following order
 - a. Highest Morris County book average for the 2023-2024 winter season, minimum of 21 games
 - b. Highest Morris County book average for the 2024 summer season, minimum of 21 games
 - c. Highest Morris County average as of November 1, 2024, minimum of 15 games
 - d. Other association highest 2023 – 2024 season average
 - e. Entrants not meeting the above requirements shall bowl scratch with an average of 225
- Verification required with entry options c & d**
- 5) Error in submitted averages will be penalized in accordance with USBC Rule 319a-3. Ten pin rule (310a-2) does not apply. Rule 319d (tournament winnings) and Rule 319e (average adjustment) are waived.
 - 6) The Tournament Director will verify all averages UPON RECEIPT of completed entry form.
 - 7) The decision of the Tournament Executive Board will be final, unless an appeal is made in accordance with the USBC Rule 329.
 - 8) Doubles event will be 3 games of 9 Pin No Tap format.
 - 9) Entrants may bowl a) singles only or b) singles and doubles.
 - 10) If a bowler wins \$600.00 or more in tournament(s) within a calendar year (January 1st to December 31st) they must be issued a 1099 miscellaneous tax form. In order for our club to comply, the bowler must submit their social security number when requested.
 - 11) All returned check fees charged to Morris County Women's 600 Club plus a \$30.00 reposit fee will be the responsibility of the person whose name appears on the check.

"Prize list" will pay 1 place for every 5 entries – Prize money returned 100%
